

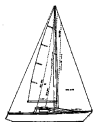

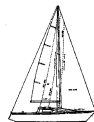
WHY YOU SHOULD ENTER

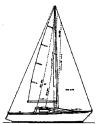


DULUTH, MINNESOTA

Lake Superior will be the setting for the 2006 San Juan 24 North American Championship July 28 - 30. Duluth is located on the western end of Lake Superior, the world's largest freshwater lake.

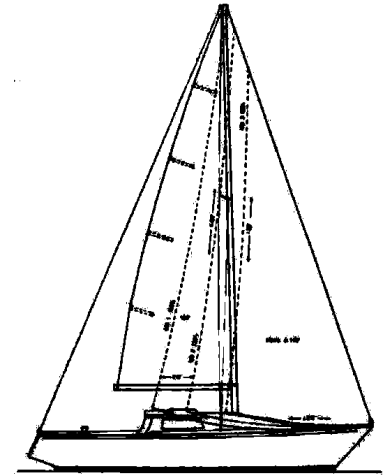
In July expect temperatures in the seventies and occasionally, eighties. The "Big Lake's" cool waters provide a built-in air conditioner yet the surface water often warms up enough for swimming. Generally, flat water and light to moderate breezes are found in July, but a strong "nor'easter" can quickly cool things down and whip up high seas.

The local San Juan 24 fleet, Fleet 14, has been the core fleet of the midwest for many years. We currently have 15 boats in our fleet ranging from hull #22 to #997. Several owners have had their boats for over 20 years while some owners just purchased their boats last year.
